Dear Parents of Grades 6 to 10,

As we continue our learning journey this week, we are pleased to share a few important updates and reminders.

In support of our commitment to student wellbeing and preventive care, we would like to inform you that Optique et Vision will be visiting the school on **Friday, February 27**, to conduct vision screenings for **Grade 6 students**. A personalized report will be shared with parents/guardians following the completion of the screening. **If no written refusal is received by Monday, February 23, consent will be assumed for your child to participate in the vision screening.**

Kindly note that from **Monday, February 16 through Wednesday, March 18**, dismissal time will be at **3:00 PM** instead of 3:15pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. On Wednesdays, school will end at **2:10 PM**.

As requested annually by the **Ministry of Education and Higher Education**, you are kindly required to submit documents and information for your children in **Grades 8 and 9**, whether or not they will be sitting for the official examinations. An informational email was sent via INFO last week. The deadline to submit the documents is **Friday, February 27**.

Kind Reminders

- Students arriving after **7:35 AM** will be marked late and will not be allowed to attend the first session.
- Students who arrive **late to class** during the day will be asked to remain outside for 10 minutes before joining the class.
- Students must be in **full school uniform (Wellspring T-shirt and Wellspring hoodie)**; otherwise, they will be provided with a loaner item, or the missing item will be purchased and charged to their tuition account.
- If a student fails to **complete homework** in the same subject twice, the student will be notified, and restorative measures will be implemented. If a student fails to complete homework in the same subject three times, parents will be notified.

- Students should **not self-administer medication**; they must hand it to the school nurse, who will ensure proper follow-up.
