Dear Early Years Parents,
We hope this message finds you and your families well.

In light of the current situation, and as the majority of our children are now attending school face-to-face, we would like to take a moment to share an update with you regarding how learning has been organized during this period.

Over the past weeks, we have been navigating a very dynamic and ever-changing context. Balancing online and face-to-face learning, while also welcoming some MYP grade levels to the Mathaf Campus, required continuous adjustments in order to ensure that learning remains consistent, meaningful, and uninterrupted. This has always been our priority, as we deeply believe that we owe this stability to both our children and our families.

As part of these adjustments, and in response to the number of attendees, some classes have been combined at different points. These decisions were taken thoughtfully, with careful consideration of children's academic progress, emotional well-being, social interactions, and overall sense of belonging within the learning community.

Throughout this phase, our focus has remained on maintaining a sense of stability, continuity, and care for all our learners.

At this point, we would like to share with you the current organization:

- **Nursery** will continue with **two sections instead of three** for the remainder of the academic year, with **all teachers present and supporting the children**. This means that children, mainly from Section B, have been thoughtfully distributed between the two sections. To ensure continuity and emotional security, **Ms. Tala and Ms. Sorina are present across both sections**, allowing children to remain connected with their familiar teachers.
- **KG1** will continue with **two sections** for the time being. This arrangement will remain in place **until further notice** and until more children fully return to face-to-face learning. At the same time, **one group will continue to be supported online**, ensuring that all learners remain engaged and included.
- **KG2** has now **returned to three sections**, with each class being guided by **its own homeroom teacher**, allowing for more stability and consistency in their daily learning experience.

We would like to reassure you that all these decisions are made with great care, always placing the children's best interests at the center, academically, socially, and emotionally.

We deeply appreciate your understanding, trust, and ongoing support during this period. Together, we continue to build a learning environment where every child feels safe, valued, and able to thrive.
